What Healthcare-Related Providers Need to Know: OSHA's COVID-19 ETS Ruling

The Coronavirus pandemic has been particularly hard on health care providers as they struggle to maintain high standards for patient and resident care amid outbreaks, staffing shortages, and shifting regulatory requirements. OSHA added to the regulatory challenges when it issued its Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) for health and related industries in June 2021.
